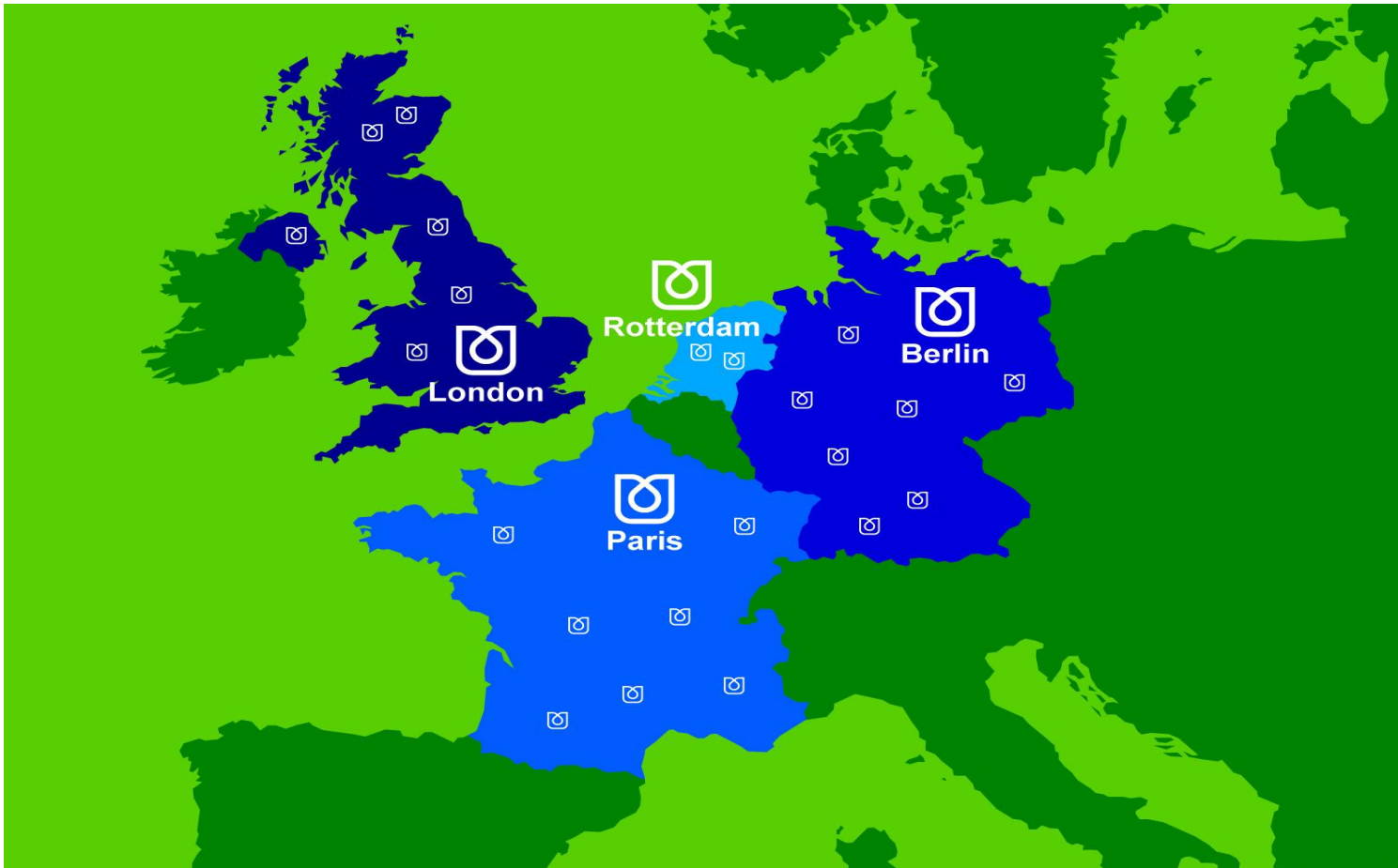

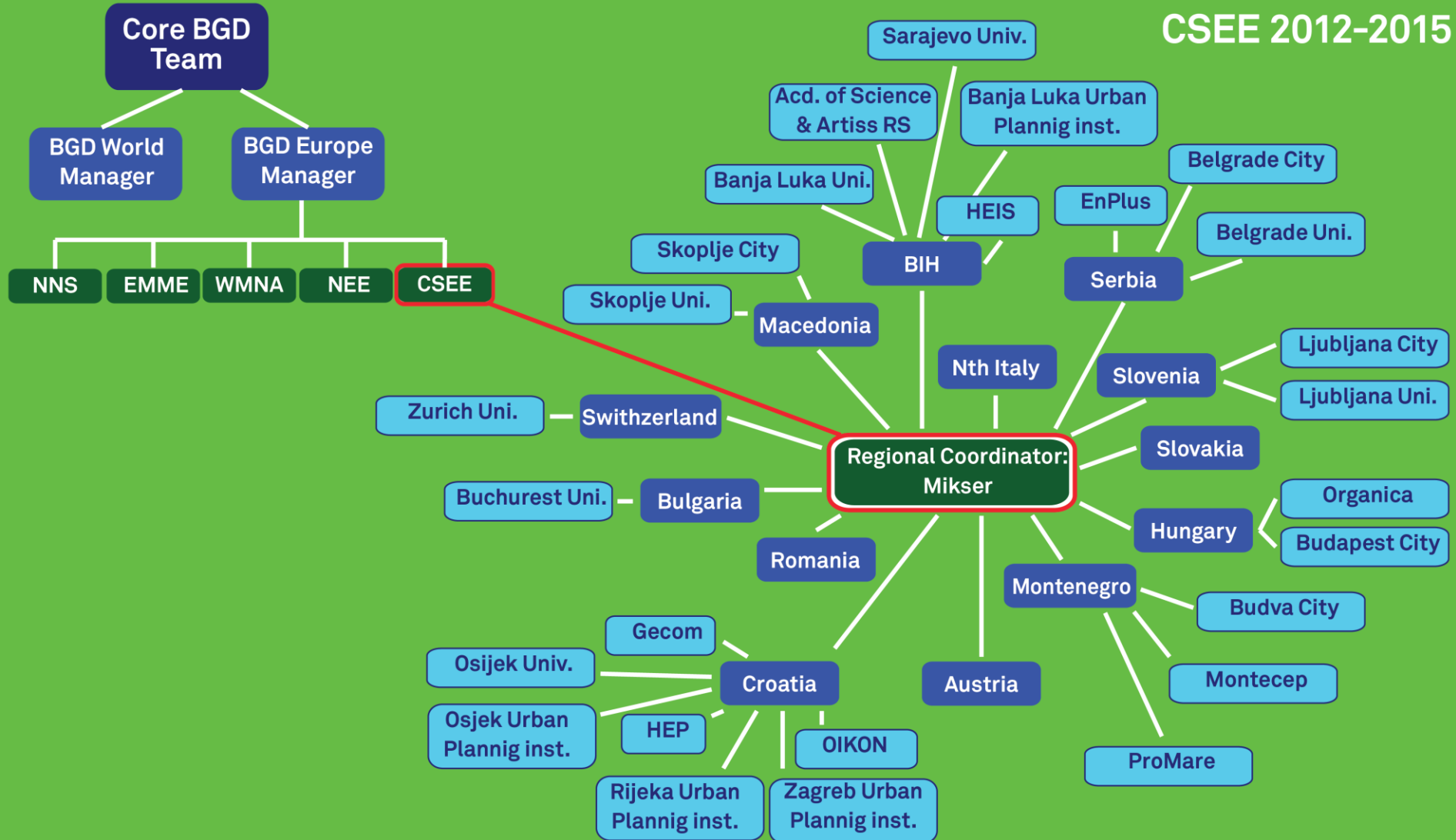

Network of BGD focal points in CSEE 2012-2015



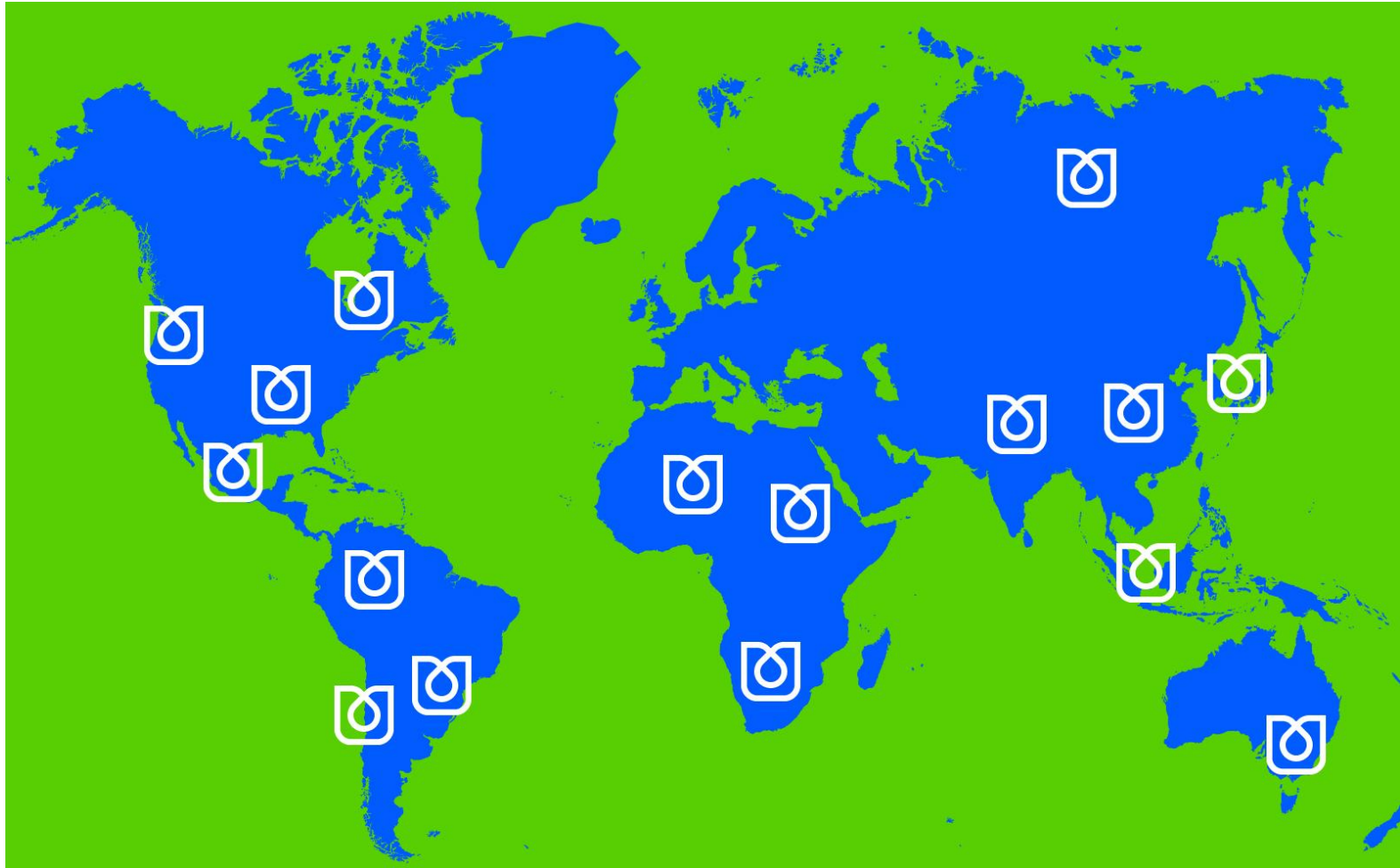
